Warrant- same

Data- start like you're telling a secret and slowly make it interesting. Change your face with this

Impact- HUGE tonal shift --Happier, hopeful, dismal, angry

Face should go with your tone

30 seconds

Last thing the judge ever hears

Conclusions should always be longer than intros

Types:

- 1) Call to action
- 2) Ethical argument – incorporate personal
- 3) Idealism
- 4) Return to original theme
- 5) Summation of ideas/refutation
